CENTRAL LIBRARY

1. About The Library

The Central Library came into existence in the year 2002 to accomplish the academic and other literary needs of the visitors. The Centrally air-conditioned library with the space of 625 Sq. Mt. has a substantial rich collection of books which includes books related to curriculum, competitive exams, reference etc. Spacious, comfortable and the congenial environment of the library help to the students and research scholars for sitting long hours.

Collection Development

We have a substantial rich collection of net 29032/- text, competitive exams, general and reference books. The library staff keeps on developing & maintaining the reading material. The library keeps on weeding out the reading material which becomes obsolete. The Library Committee has fixed 12 years shelf life of the books. Every year we keep on writing off books and adding new books as per the study scheme and on the recommendations of the Head of the Departments.

Arrangement of Documents

All the books have been classified as per 22nd edition of Dewey Decimal Classification Scheme. The subject-wise books have been arranged on Shelves.

All the books are catalogued as per Anglo American Cataloguing Rules-II. We have set up a Catalogue Cabinet at the entrance of the library where all the cards have been arranged alphabetically.

Periodical Section

The library has a separate section for all the magazines & newspapers. We have subscribed 20 magazines & 14 newspapers for this section. This section helps the visitors to keep them abreast with the latest developments in the various fields.

Competitive Exam Section

The library has given a dedicated section to the books which are related to various Competitive Exams like GATE, CAT, MAT, GMAT, GRE, UPSC, Civil Services Examination, SBI, PO etc. We have procured the latest competitive exam books particularly for GATE 2022. The students keep this section busy for their career prospects. We have more than 1500 Competitive Exam Books in this section.

Circulation Section

This section plays a key role to hand over the exact document to the borrowers which is required by them. In other words all the documents are issued & returned and the record of the same is well maintained in this section. Due to ongoing pandemic, the books are not in much circulation.

Nine Cubicles

The spacious library includes Nine Cubicles. These cubicles have been set up mainly for the research scholars for their focused and concentrated studies. The demand for these cubicles is always high among the students.

User Education Programme

User Education Programme is the regular feature of the Central Library. All the first year students and new joining are introduced with the different section & services of the library. The programme is conducted in 15-16 groups of students which takes 2-3 days to complete. A lecture is given to the students and followed by a tour of different sections of the library.

Digital Library

We have a Digital Library where 20 systems have set up with internet connectivity. The visitors may access numerous E-books, E-journals and other E-resources.

E-Resources

The visitors may access 303 E-books, E-journals and 93 self-learning websites in the Digital Library.

Library Automation

The Central Library is partially automated. All the books are accessioned on computer. The issue and return system has been computerized. We are in the process to start the bar coding of the books and to have Online Public Access Catalogue for searching a particular book.

Library Services

The library staff plays a vital role for strengthening the teaching-learning process. The staff members show full dedication, zeal and enthusiasm to provide the following services;

Current Awareness Service

All the members of faculty/staff and students are regularly kept updated with the new advancements in the Central Library. We use to circulate New Arrival list and same is displayed on the notice board.

Reference Service

The personal assistance is provided to the users seeking a specific piece of information. In case a particular information is not available in the library then user needs to fill a form and same is arranged in a day or two afterwards.

Book Club

The Central Library has a Book Club which is running successfully which was initiated by honourable Madam Ragini Sharma. We conducted club's 18th meeting on 3rd Dec. 2020 at AGC Organic Farm. In this meeting we reviewed Sapiens by Yuval Noah Harari.

We conducted club's 19th meeting on 22nd Feburary 2021 at AGC Organic Farm. The members of the club reviewed "Mandara" by Pooja Dilawari. This meeting was also joined by the author of the book. She narrated couple stories from the book and her experiences with this book.

Online Mock Campus Placement

Every year we conduct Mock Campus Placement Drive in the college. But due to ongoing pandemic it was really challenging to go for online mode to conduct MCP. The students of Students 'Library Committee took the challenge and we were able to organize Online Mock Campus Placement from 29th April to 4th May 2021. Mr. Aashutosh Bhat, Ex Vice President, was the keynote speaker for Pre-Placement Talk.
