Instructions Regarding New System of Examination

It is for the information of all the students that w.e.f. May 2023 Semester End Exams, we are going to have new system of examination in regard to pattern of question paper, timings of examination and new answer sheets. All the students need to know the following changes in the examination system and abide by the same to act accordingly;

1. New pattern of Question Paper:

The question paper will have section A and section B. Section A will have 12 questions which will carry 02 marks each and Section B will have 06 questions which will carry 06 marks each as shown below;

NOTE: All the questions are compulsory and there will be no choice.

2. New timings of Examination

The students shall attempt the question paper in the maximum given time of 2 hours 30 minutes. Each exam timing will be from 9:30 am to 12:00 noon and 1:00 pm to 3:30 pm for morning and evening session, respectively.

3. New format of answer sheets

After finishing the old answer sheets of 32 pages (earlier it had first 4 printed pages) the students will be distributed new format answer sheets in the examination hall. The new format answer sheets will have 24 pages (it will have first 2 printed pages) and interested students will be allowed to take maximum 2 supplementary sheets (each with 4 pages) during an exam. Further students are advised to ensure that

- (i) No page in the answer sheet is damaged.
- (ii) Except first 2 pages rest all pages are blank.

If there is any problem with the Answer Sheet that must be brought into the notice of the concerned invigilator. The students shall ensure that this process shall take place before writing anything on the Answer Sheet.

Note:

- Rest of the instructions will be applicable as per the previous practice. The students are advised to contact in the department in case of any doubt or confusion.
- 2. The above instructions are not applicable (except point 3) for the students of MCA, M.Tech., BAJMC, B. Pharmacy, B.Sc. MLS, B.Voc. and B.Tech. students having subjects with BT Code (old study scheme).
