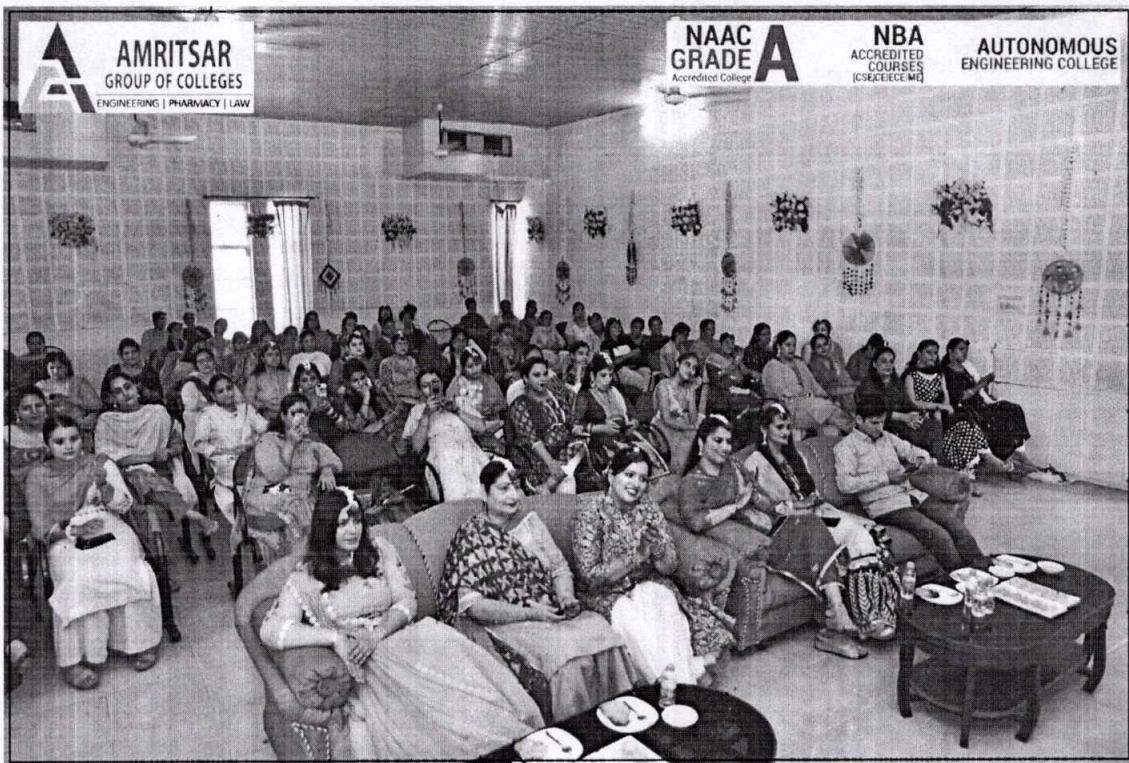
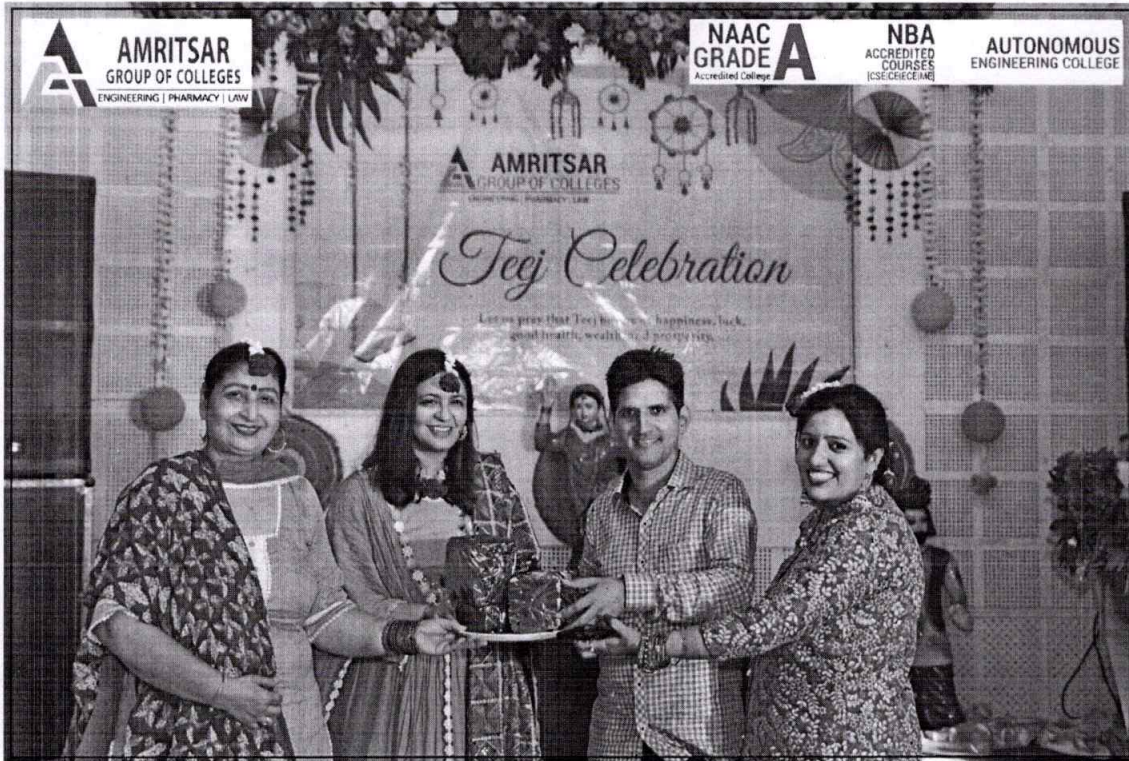


## Teej Celebration- 18<sup>th</sup> August 2021

## Webinar on Menstruation and Hygiene - 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2021

Menstrual hygiene is a hygienic practice during menstruation which can prevent women from the infection in reproductive and urinary tract. Dr. Monika Maheshwary, MBBS, MS (Obstetrics & Gynaecology), Consultant Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Amandeep Hospital delivered a webinar for the Female Faculty and Staff members of Amritsar Group of Colleges on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2021 on Menstrual Hygiene where she told Hygiene-related practices of women during menstruation are of considerable importance, as it may increase vulnerability to Reproductive Tract Infections (RTI's). She further explained that Poor menstrual hygiene can lead to many issues, such as **fungal or bacterial infections of the reproductive tract** and the urinary tract. Irritation of the skin causes discomfort and can possibly result in dermatitis – a medical condition in which the skin swells, turns red, and at times becomes sore with blisters. She reiterated the following measures to ascertain proper menstrual hygiene

1. Change your sanitary napkin every 4-6 hours- ...
2. Wash yourself properly- ...
3. Don't use soaps or vagina hygiene products- ...
4. Discard the sanitary napkin properly

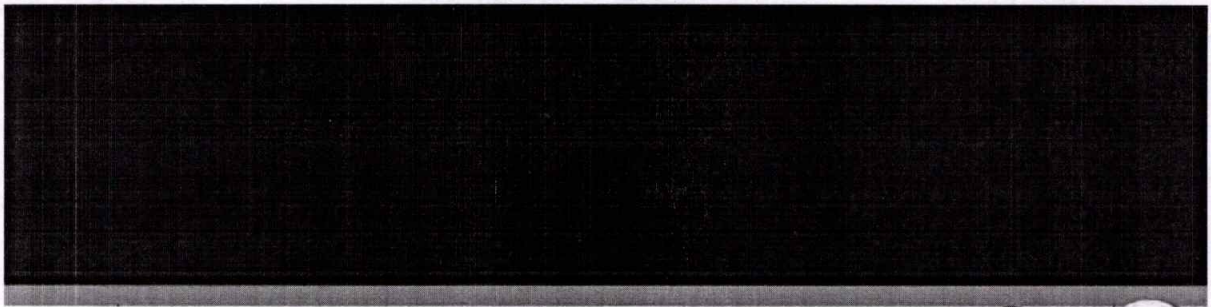

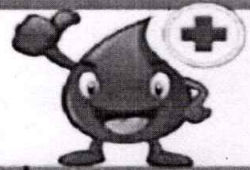

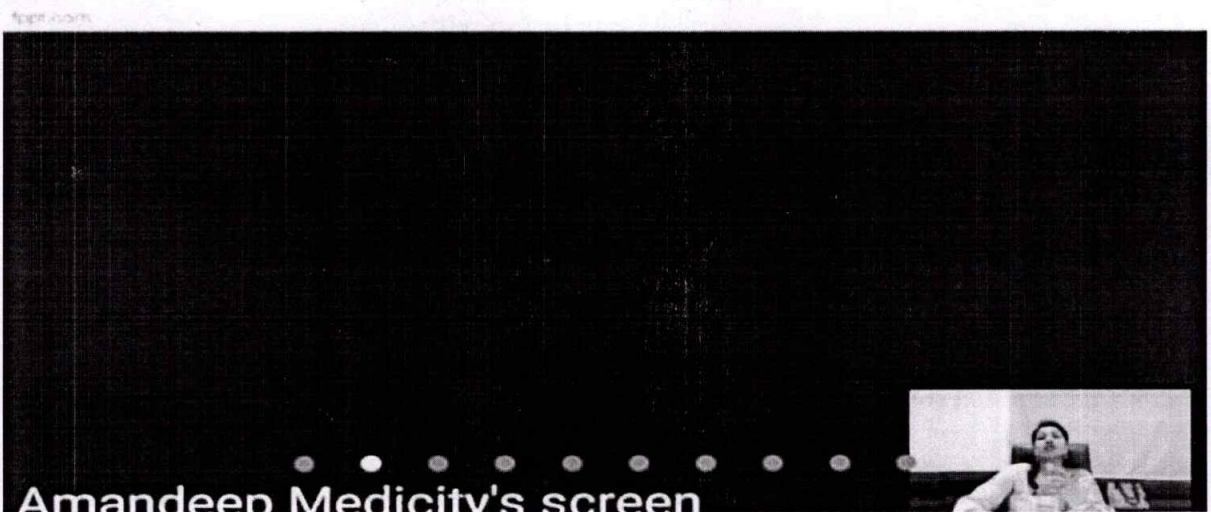




## The Cycle

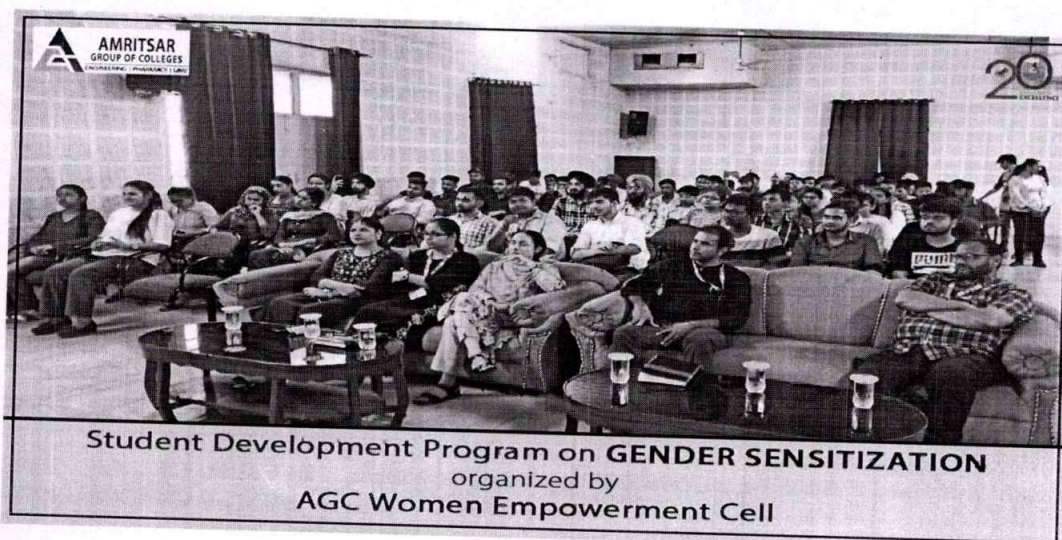
- celebrate women's achievements

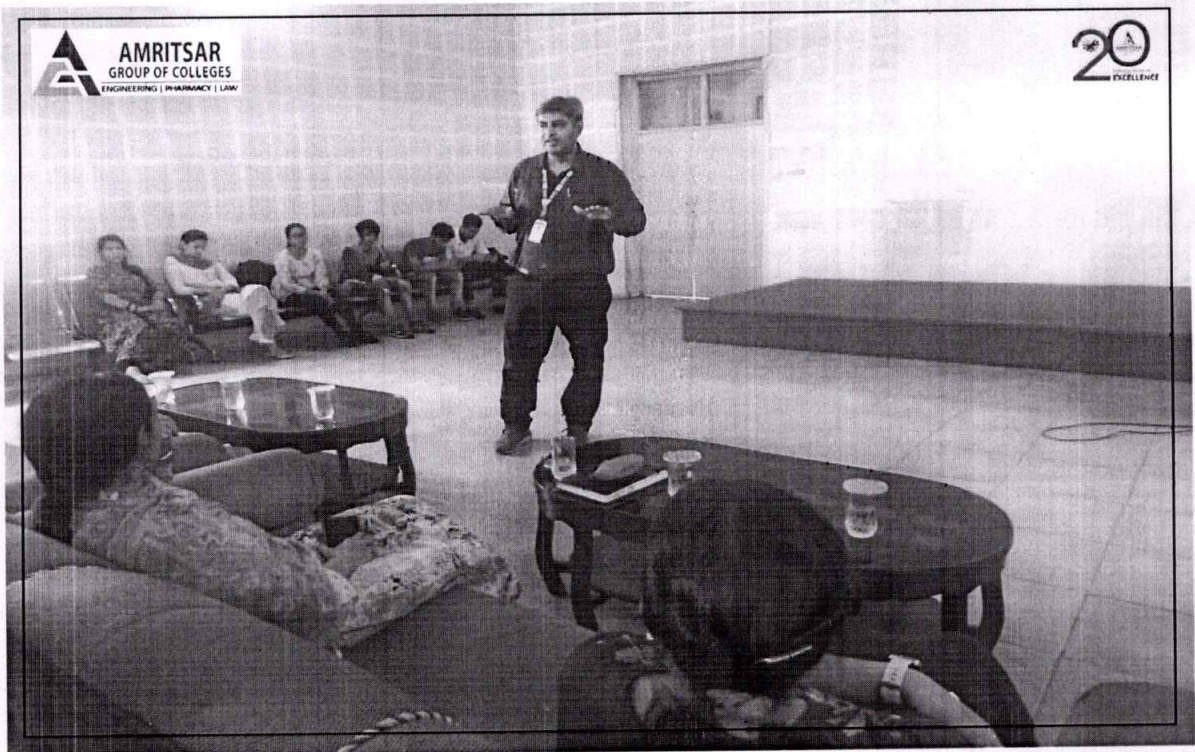
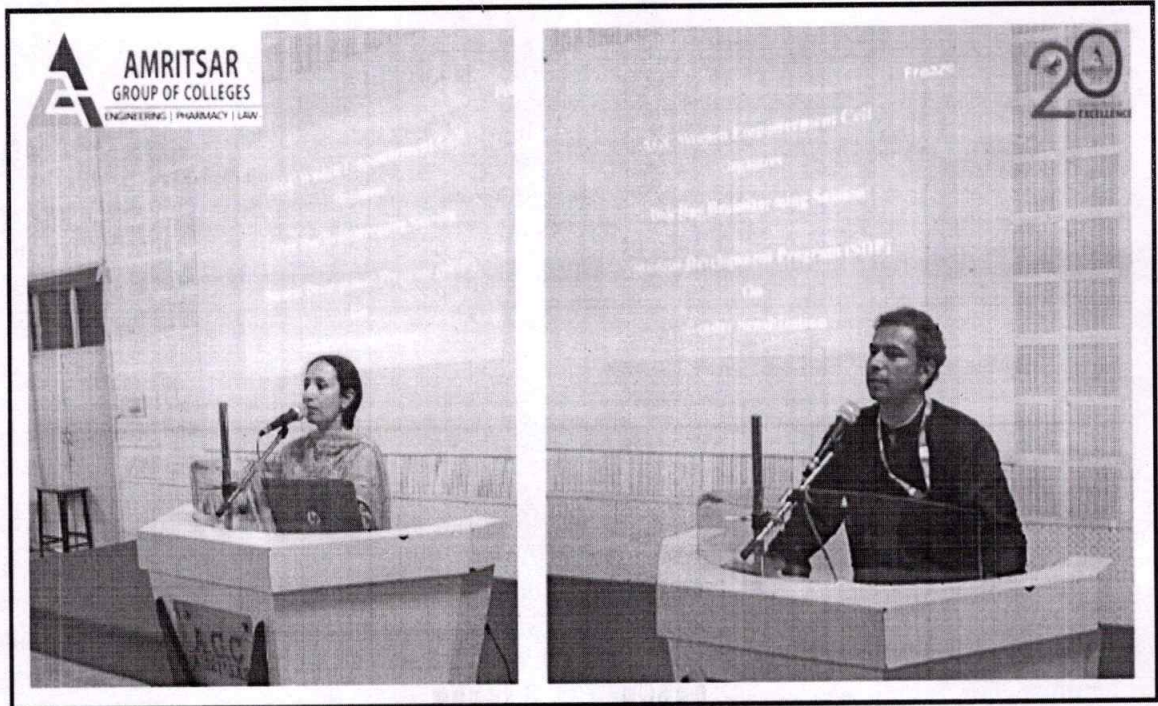
## Two Day Brainstorming Session on Gender Sensitization from August 31, 2022 to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022

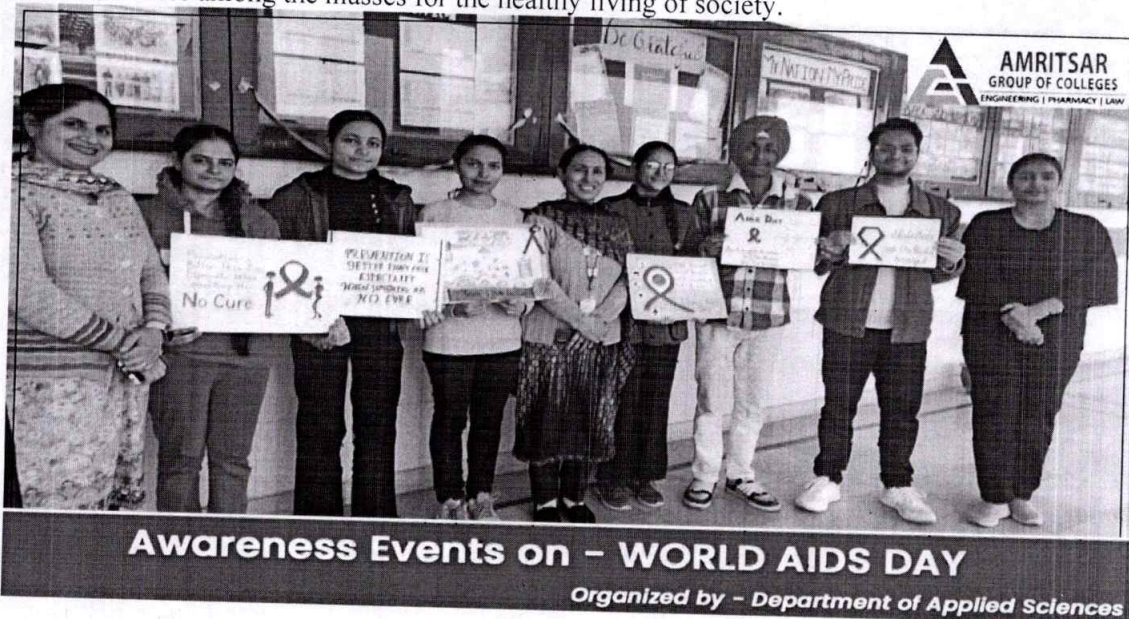






## World AIDS Day: December 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022

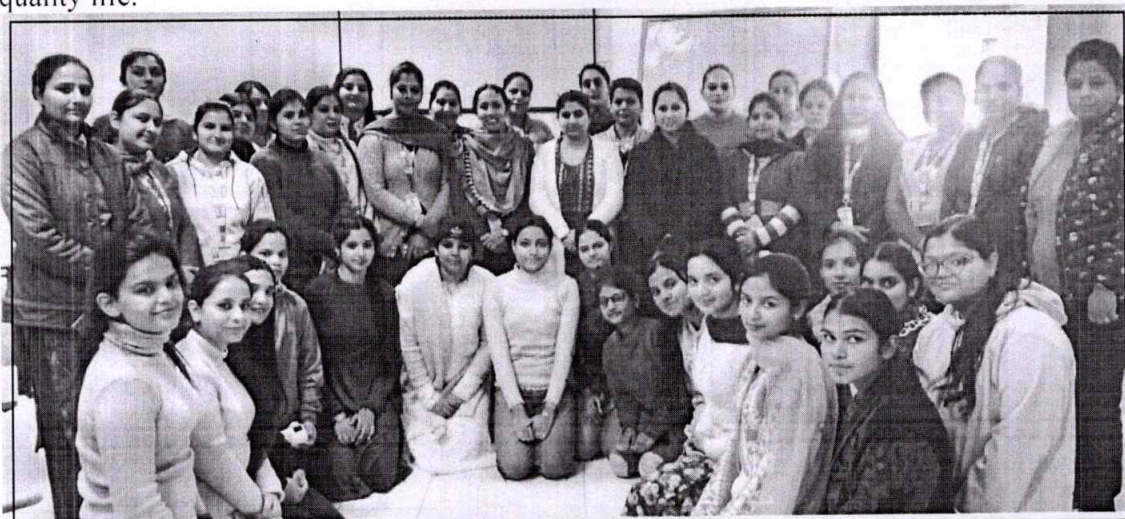




#### **Motivational Lecture on " How to lead Quality Life" - 14<sup>th</sup> Dec 2022**

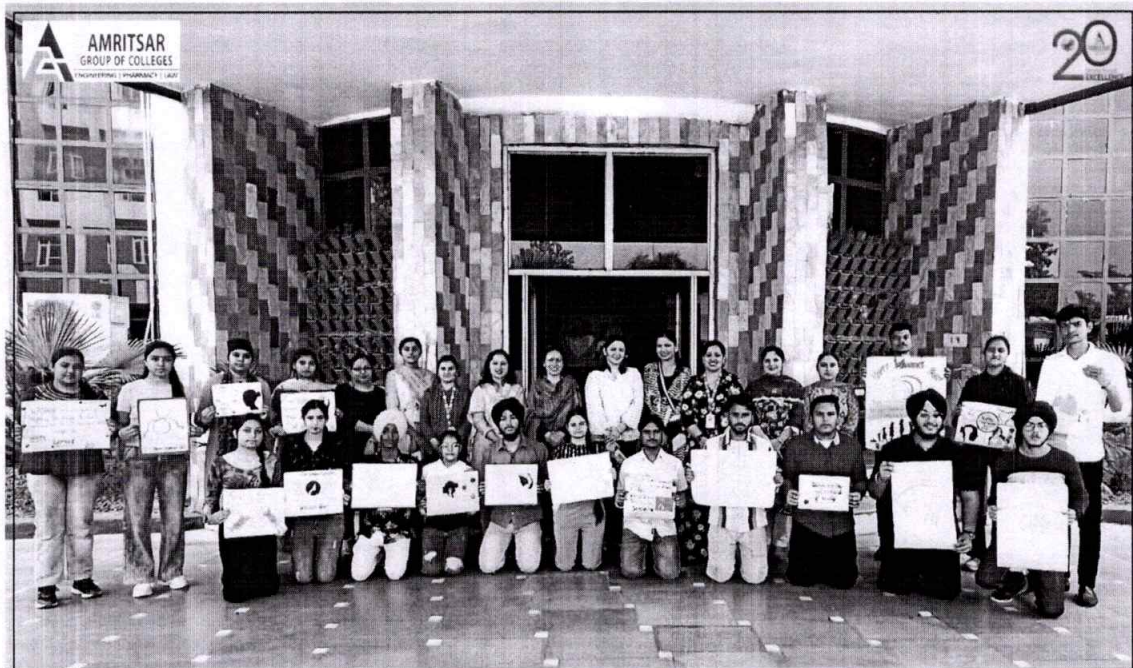


### **Women Empowerment Week from March 20-24, 2023**

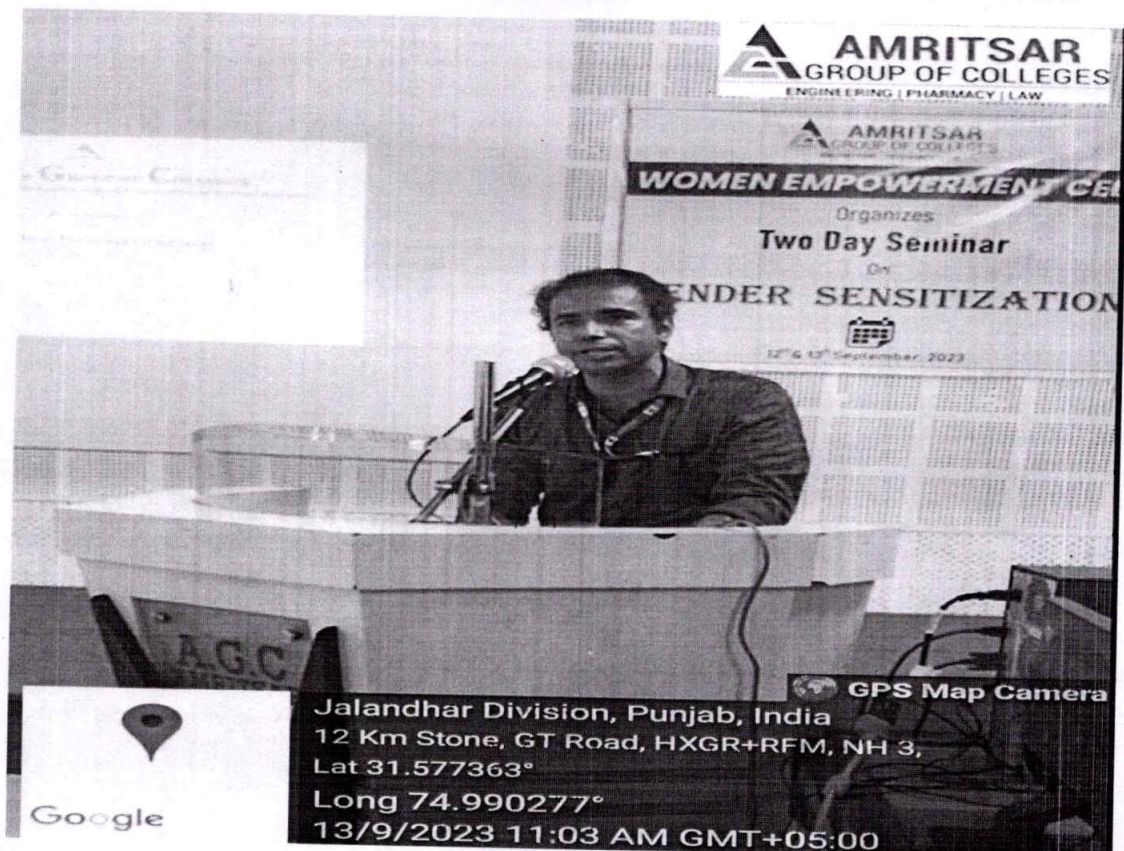
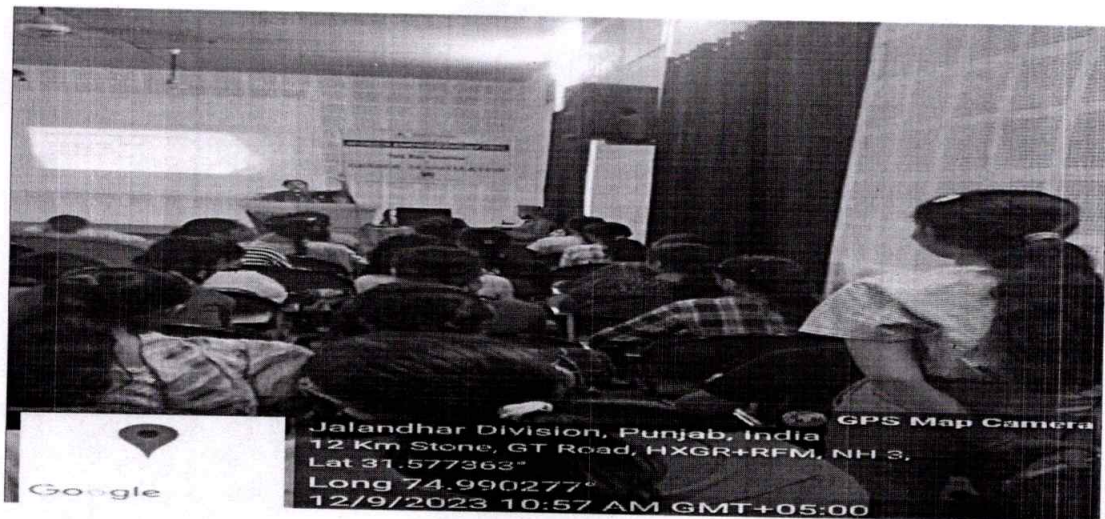




## Two days' Seminar on "Gender Sensitization" - September 12 & 13, 2023

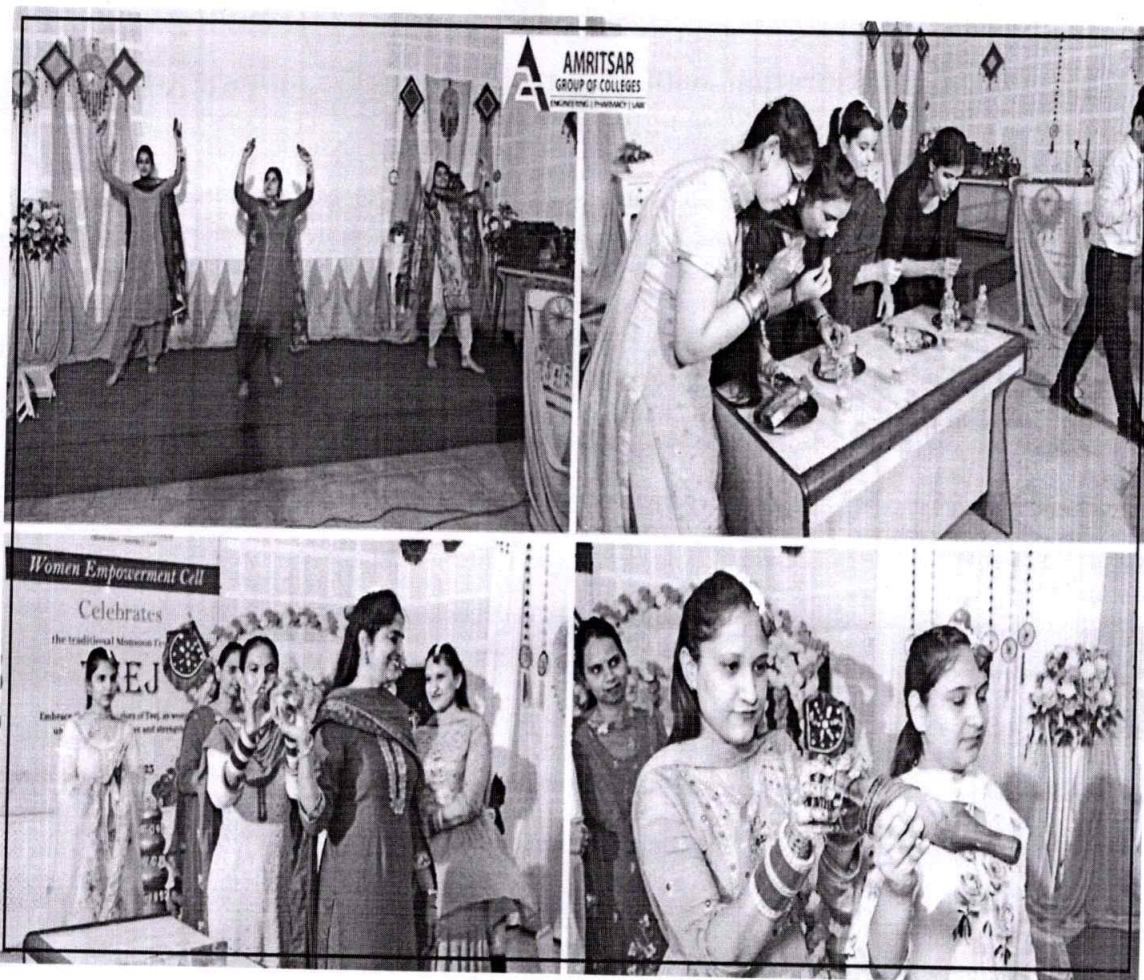


## Teej Festival Celebration: 13<sup>th</sup> August 2024

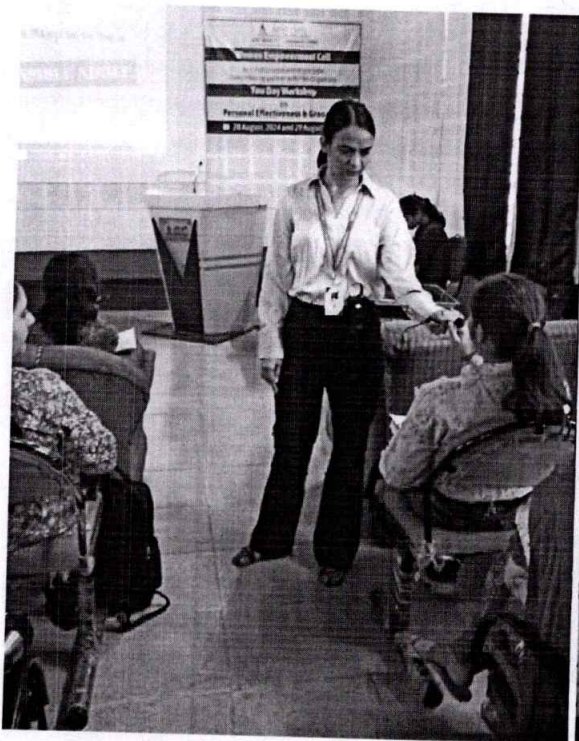




### **Workshop in collaboration with Right Side Story Training Partner on “Empowering Women” – 28<sup>th</sup> August 2024**

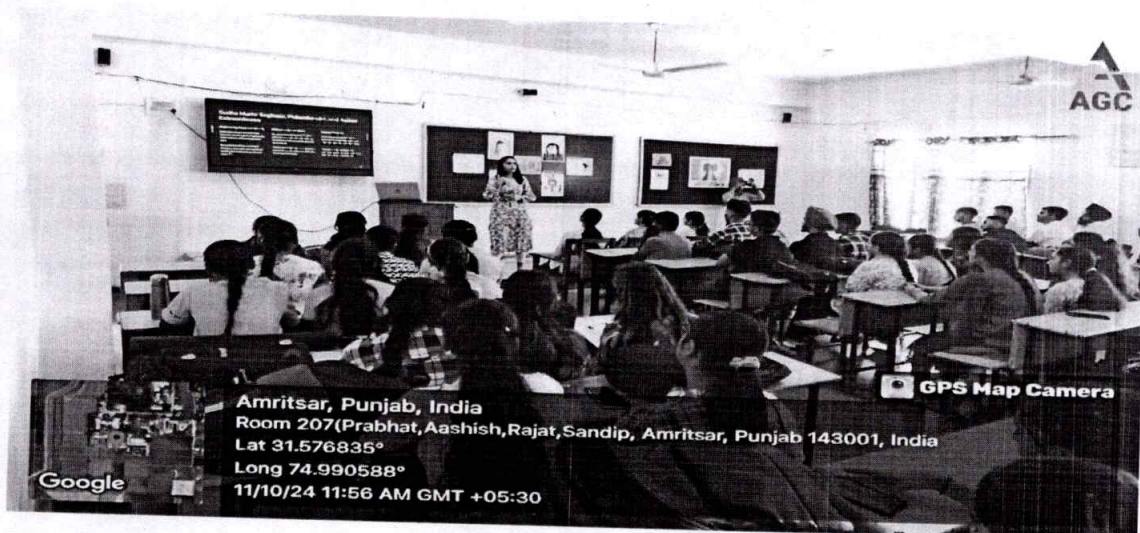

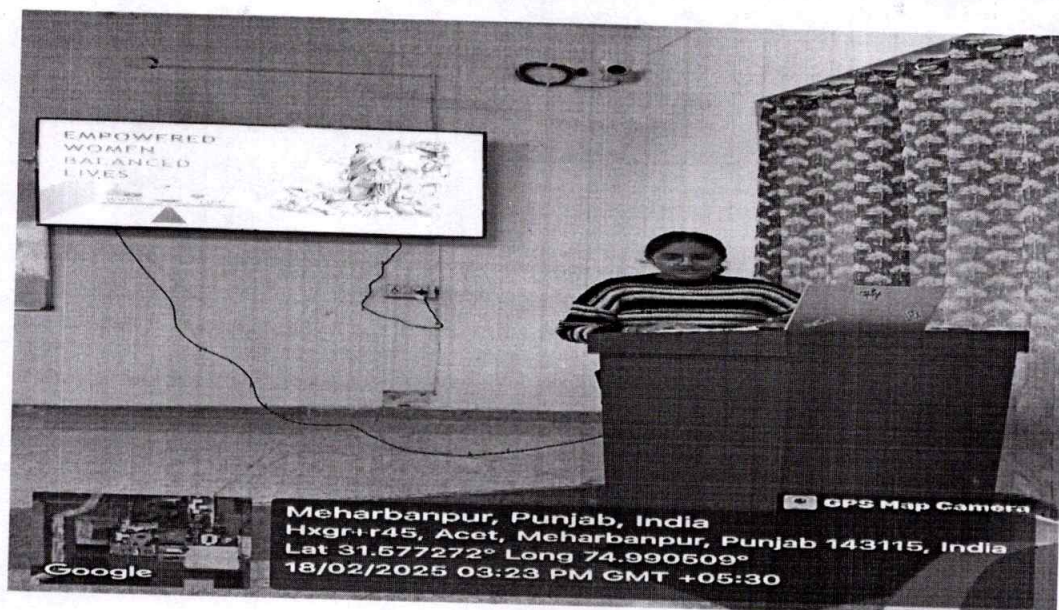
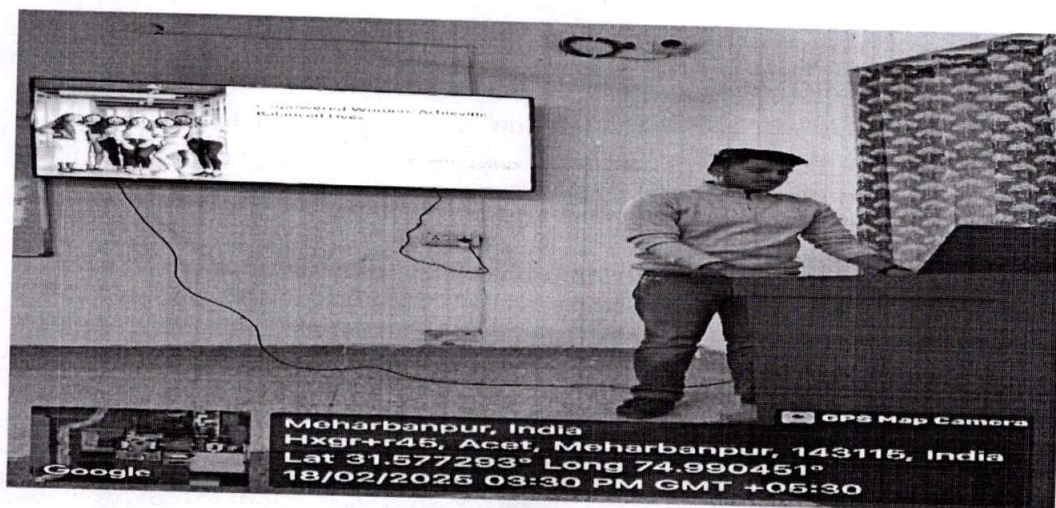


### Group Discussion on Women's Health: 24<sup>th</sup> January 2025

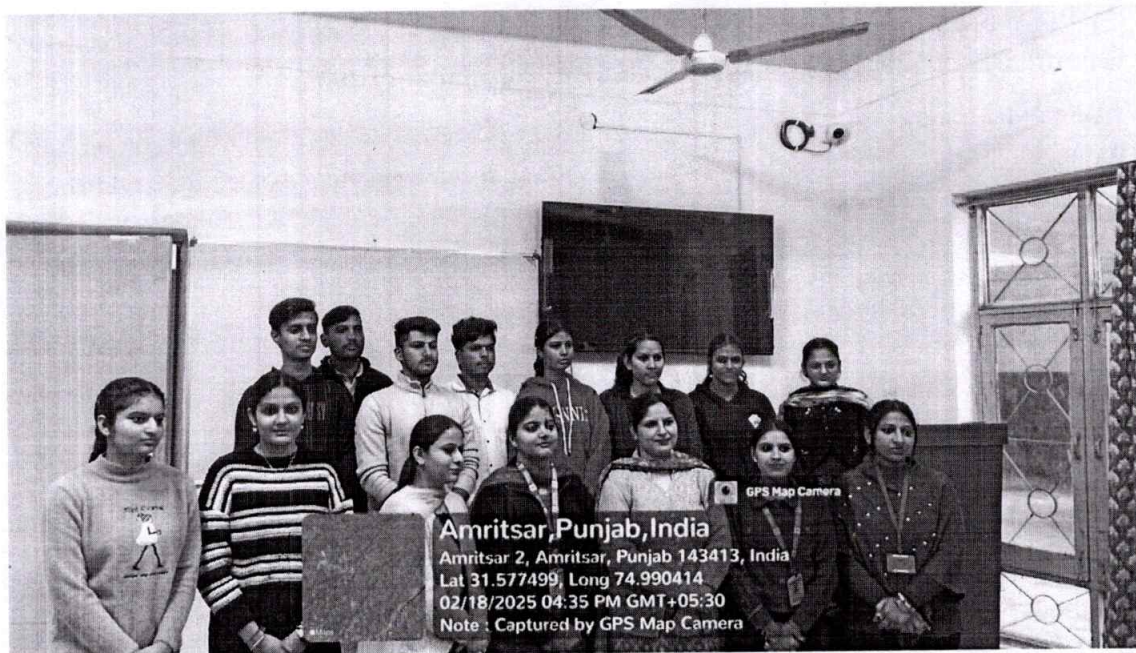

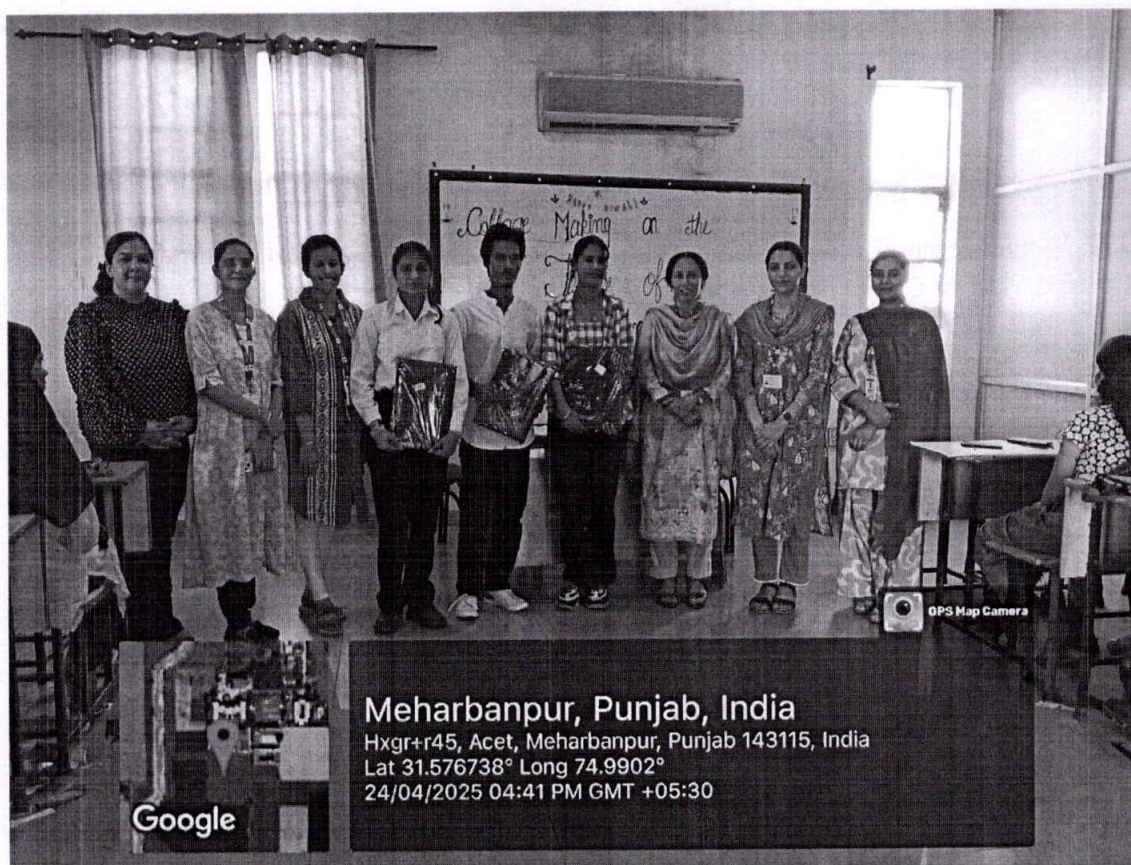
### Collage Making Competition: 24<sup>th</sup> April 2025

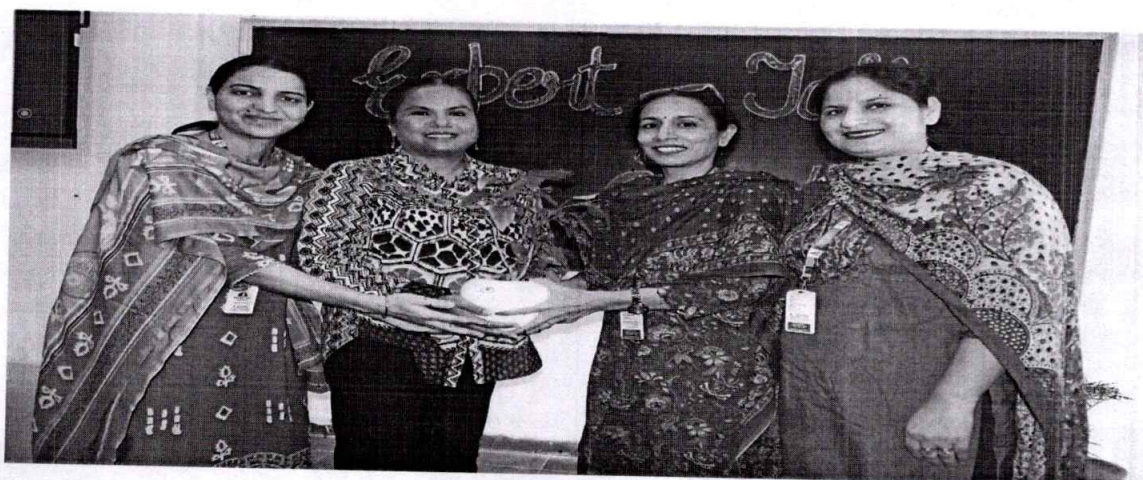
### Expert Talk on Gender Sensitisation: 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2025

## Seminar on “Demystifying AI: How to Get Started, Stand Out & Succeed” -15th Sept 2025

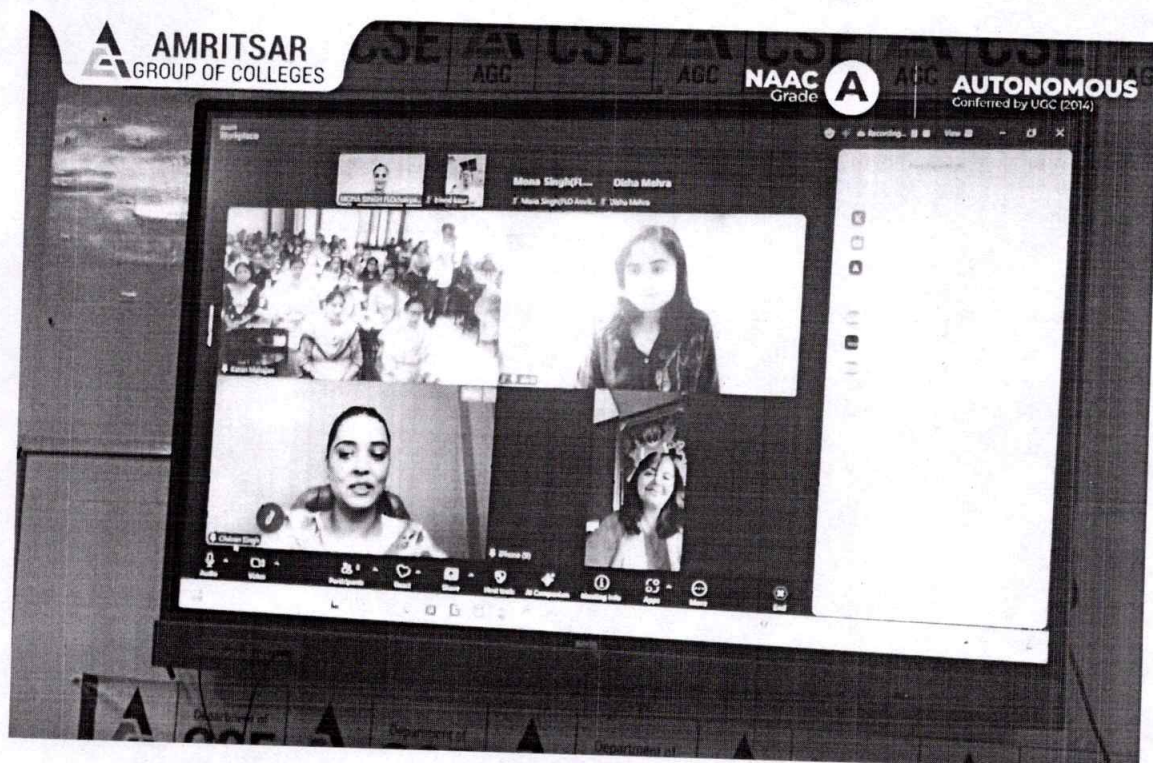
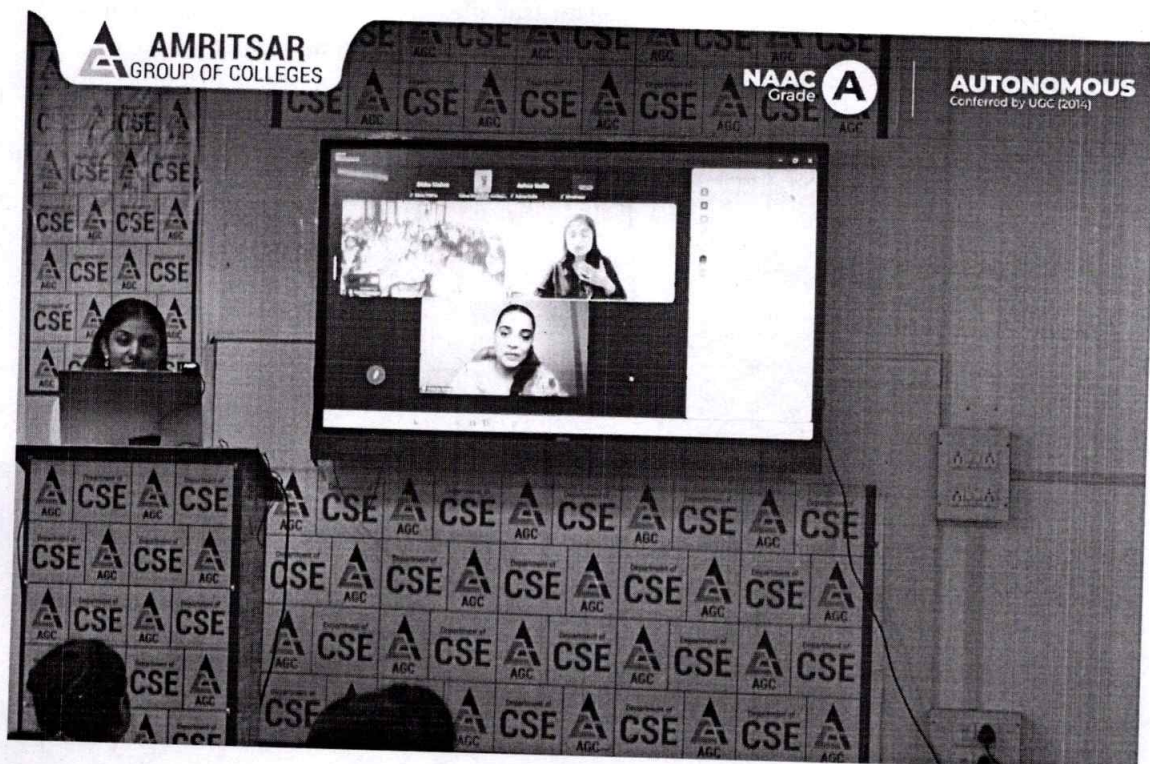

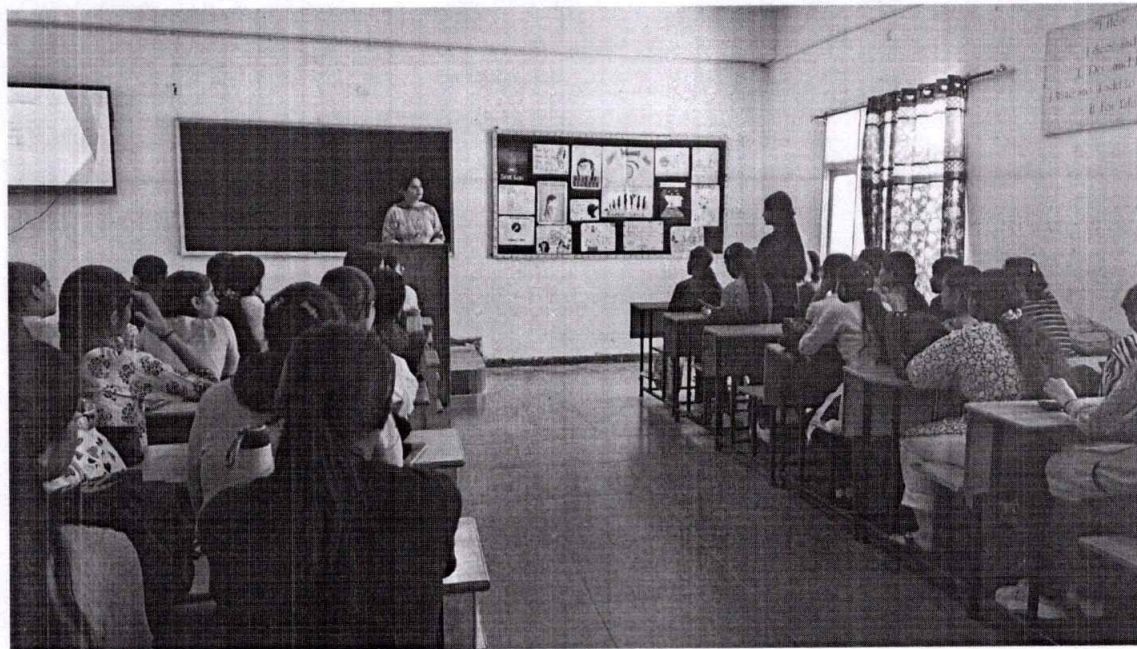




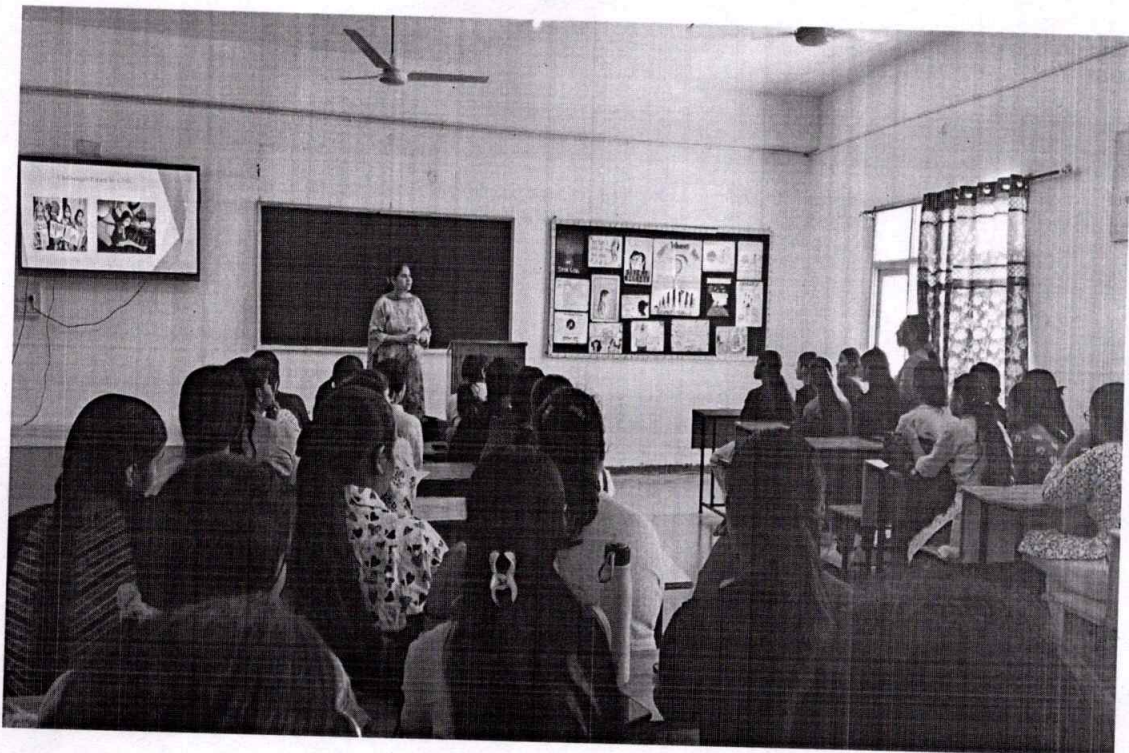


## International Girl Child Day: 11<sup>th</sup> October 2025
