**The following Agenda will be discussed:**



- Damage to college property by a hostel student involving the breaking of a college bus window glass.

**Minutes of Meeting**

**3. Misconduct During Cricket Tournament Match**

The committee reviewed the incident in which a student was involved in physical misconduct during a cricket tournament match. After discussion, a warning letter was issued to the student, and the student was removed from the match with immediate effect for violating discipline and sportsmanship.

**4. Argument Between Roommates in Girls Hostel**



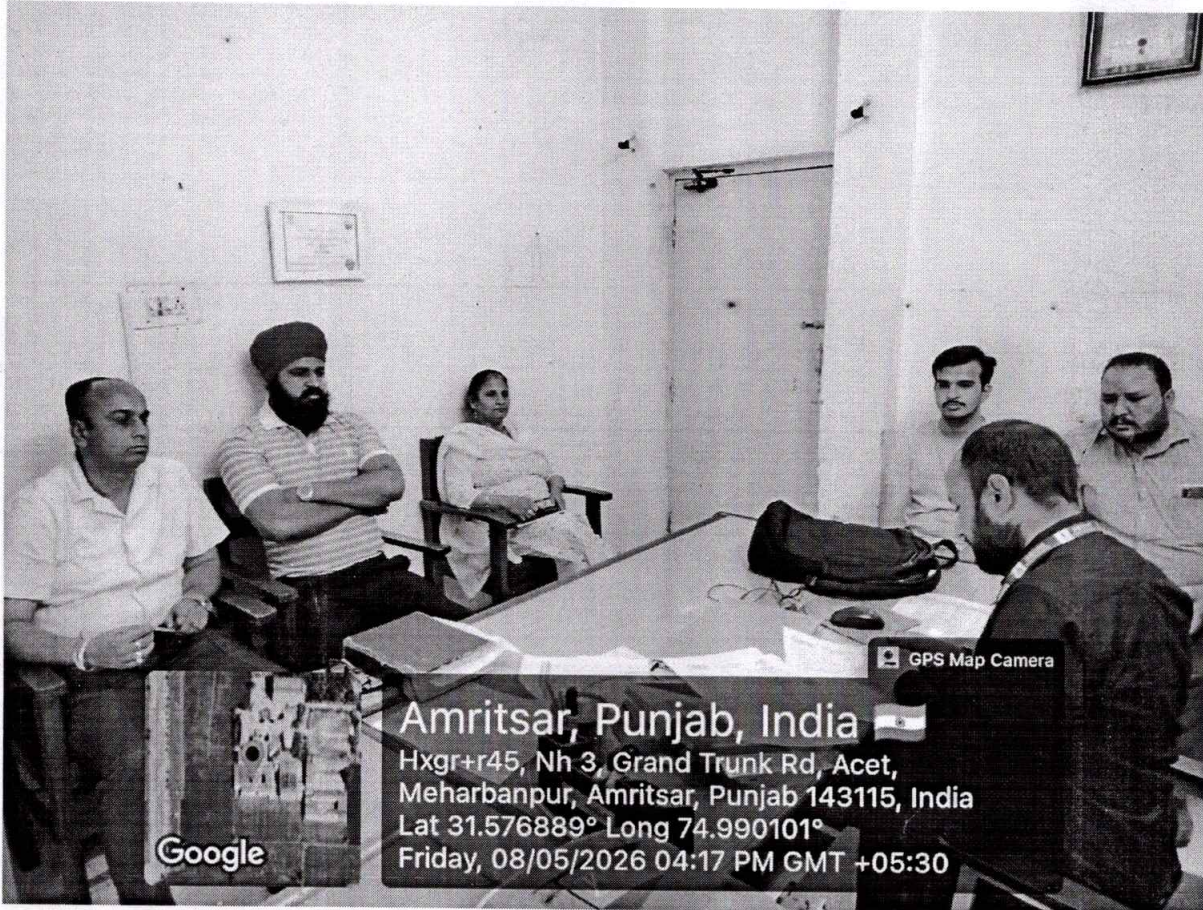
**5. Preventive and Disciplinary Measures**

**Subject: Imposition of Repair Cost and Warning for Damage to College Property**
