Proceedings

However, based on the written confessions of the students, the committee decided to verify the answer sheets of University Roll Nos. 2131852, 2131853, 2131907 & 2131909 to check the similarities in their answers. Accordingly, if there will be any observation the case will be sent to UMC Committee. Otherwise, with a warning the captured mobiles shall be returned to the concerned students.








