

It was decided that short departmental talks, posters, and gentle awareness reminders will be rolled out within the next two weeks. 3. Faculty coordinators from those departments will assist with scheduling sessions. 4. Student volunteers agreed to help circulate materials and guide new students where needed. 	All members
