## Minutes of Meeting

A committee was constituted by the office of Vice Chancellor vide letter IKGPTU/VC/42 dated 03-07-2025 to suggest a plan to rollout an 'Entrepreneurship Mindset Curricular' in B.Tech., BBA, BCA, and B.Voc. degree programs from 2025-26 batch in response to advisory issued by Punjab Government vide HED-EDU10M.L/5/2025-3edu dated 30.06.2025.

The committee has received syllabus, teaching plan, and outline for evaluation criteria for Entrepreneurship Setup and Launch. An online meeting was conducted by the committee in 04-07-2025 at 7:30pm, deliberated at length and recommends the following unanimously:

1. In today's era, entrepreneurship is very much required to fulfill achieve the target of developed India by 2047. IKGPTU Kapurthala has already included many courses in teaching curricula of most degree programs.
2. Since the Government of Punjab has taken the initiative to inculcate entrepreneurship mindset among college students, IKGPTU Kapurthala should also adopt the same and align its curricula for B.Tech., BBA, BCA, and B.Voc. degree programs for batch 2025-26 onwards.
3. The committee recommends to teach total five subjects throughout the degree programs. Three subjects will be common for all degrees (and specializations) and course code and contents will be same for all.
4. The remaining two subjects will be open for the respective Board of Studies to make fine tuning as per requirements of degree and specialization.
5. Each subject will be taught as a practical course with two weekly slots of two hours each (total 04 hours). Accordingly, the number of credits will be 02 for each course and a total of 10 for all five courses. All BOS will make required changes in study schemes of all degree programs. Course evaluation will be similar to existing university norms (60 internal + 40 external = 100 marks).
6. Teachers involved in Entrepreneurship Development Cell of each college and volunteer teacher those are interested in teaching said courses will get resources and training from Punjab Government as per issued advisory.
7. Each BOS can adopt one course (syllabus attached) in the first year for batch 2025-26. BOS should decide whether to teach in the first semester or in second semester depending on lesser number credits.
8. To expedite the finalization of required changes in the study scheme of batch 2025-26 chairpersons of all BOSs are advised to conduct online meetings or conduct BOS meeting Agenda by Circulation before July 15, 2025. The same may be rectified in the next BOS meeting.
9. Further, in upcoming physical meetings BOSs should reconsider deletion of similar courses in other semesters to avoid repetition of similar contents.
